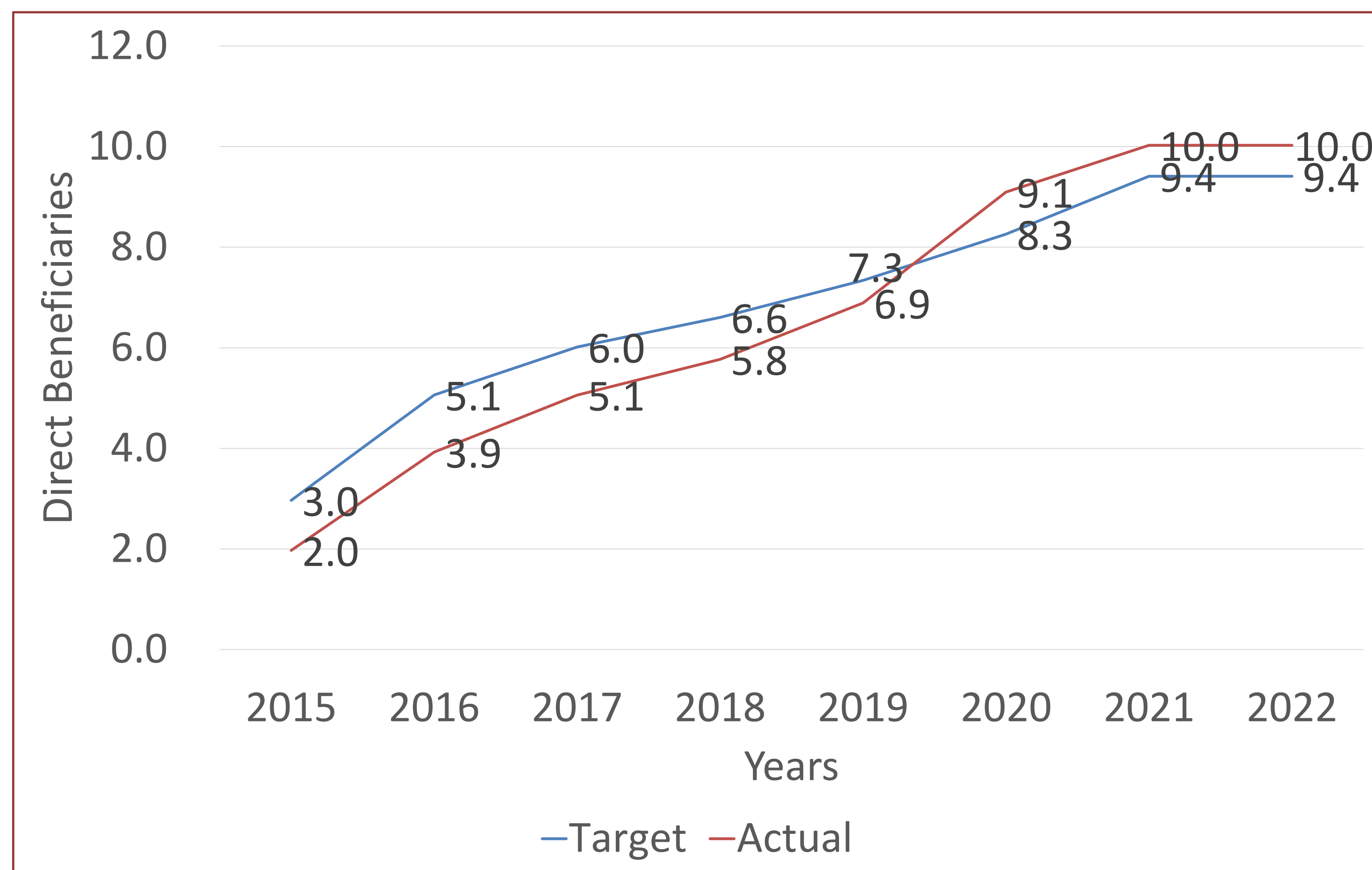


Fig.1. Number of cumulative total direct beneficiaries reached and annual project targets ('000).

- The project worked with more than 10,000 direct beneficiary farmers in testing and validating various technology, as opposed to the target of 9,410 farmers.

DIRECT BENEFICIARIES BY COUNTRY

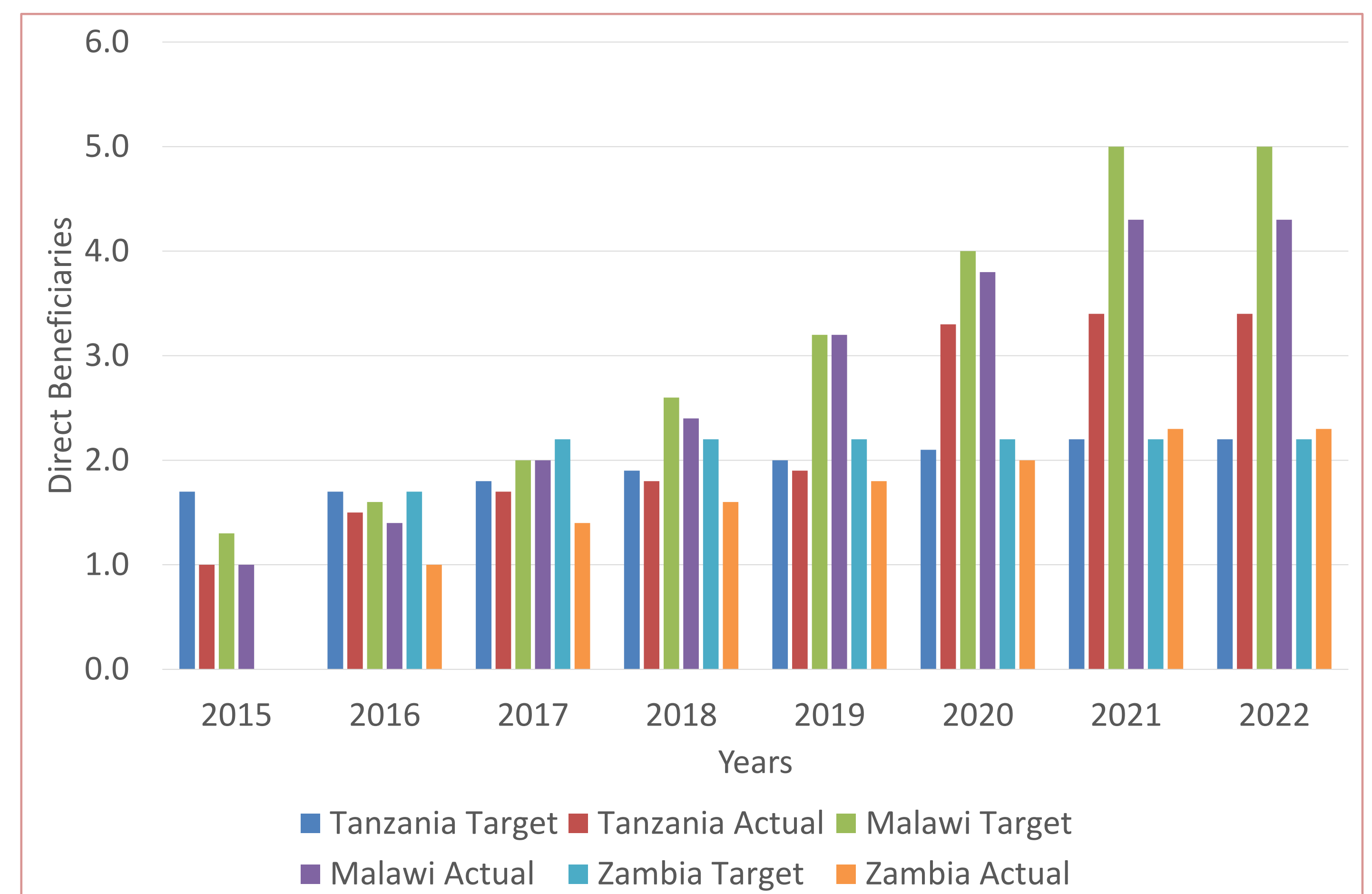


Fig.2. Number of cumulative direct beneficiary farmers reached and annual project targets by country ('000).

- By project-end, the total beneficiaries were 3,400 in Tanzania, 4,300 in Malawi, and 2,300 in Zambia (corresponding to 157%, 86%, and 104% of targeted beneficiaries in each country, respectively)

TOTAL SCALING BENEFICIARIES REACHED

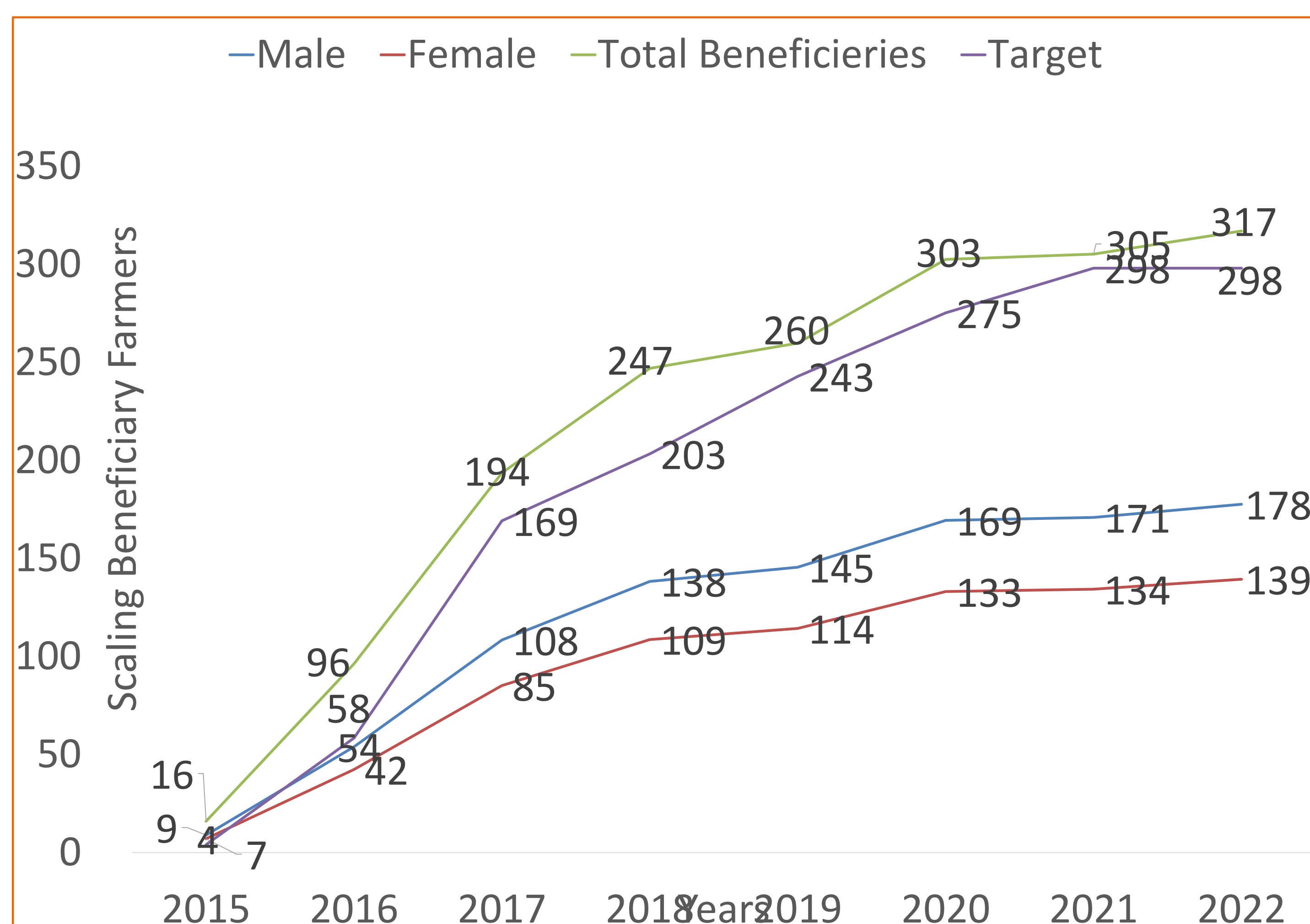


Fig.3: Number of total direct beneficiaries reached and annual project target ('000).

- The project reached about 317,000 scaling beneficiary farmers in testing and validating various Africa RISING technologies, as opposed to the target of about 298,000 farmers (corresponding to a ratio of 106%).

SCALING BENEFICIARIES REACHED BY COUNTRY

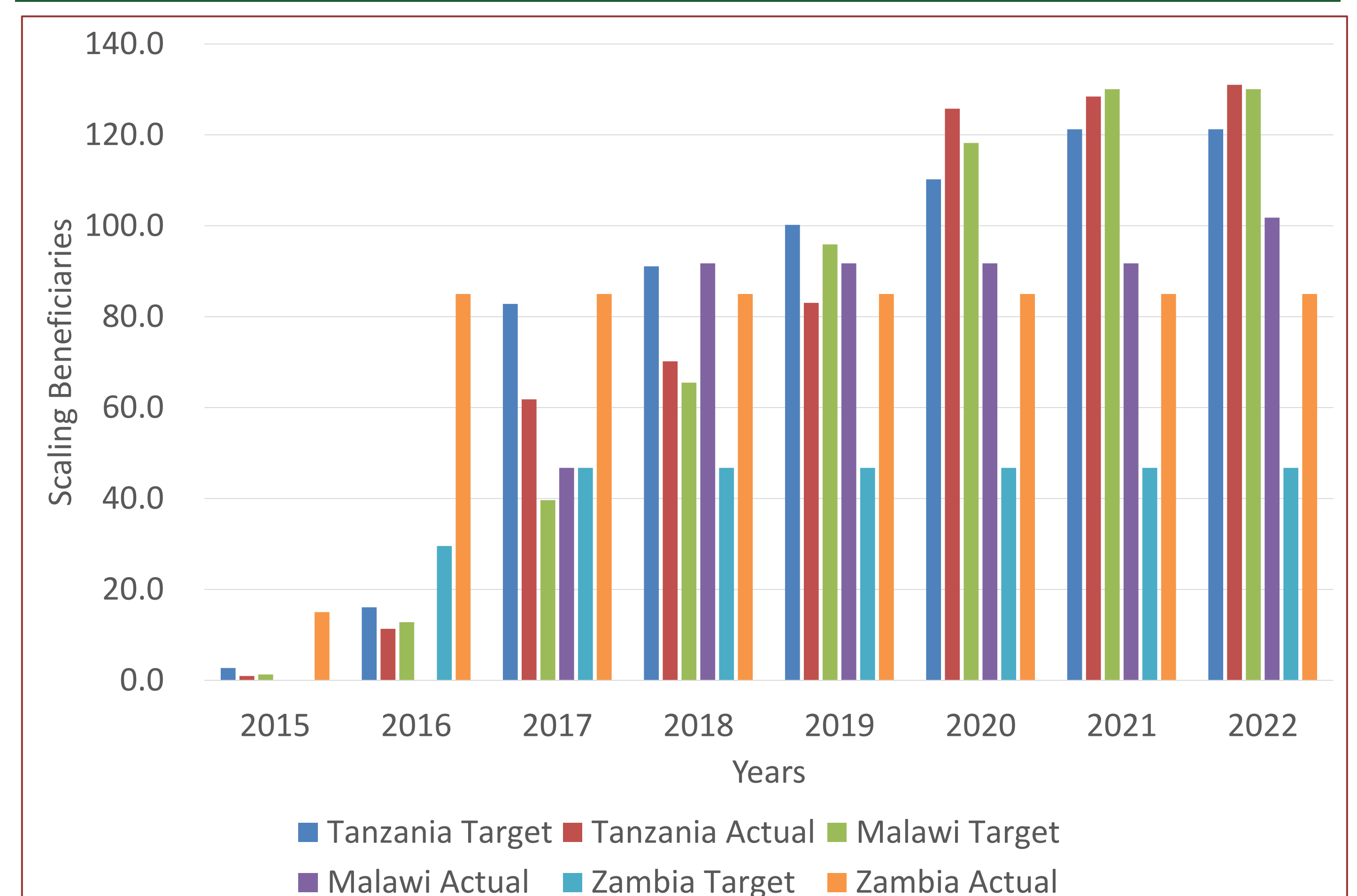


Fig.4: Number of scaling beneficiaries reached and annual project targets by country ('000).

- By project-end, the total scaling beneficiaries were 131,000 in Tanzania, 101,800 in Malawi, and 85,000 in Zambia (corresponding to a ratio with targets by 182%, 108%, and 78% respectively).
